Must Include:

- A minimum of 5 images of self and family members
- Maps marking countries of family origin
- Image of family tree
- Oral explanation of one page of your year book (you must include this one, but it is your choice as to which page you explain).
- Music
- An introduction slide at the beginning of your montage and a transition slide at the end.

Your Choice (choose 2):

- Explanation of finger printing activity and photos
- Common medical conditions of family
- Origin of family name
- Include parts of interview with family member
- Explanation of physical traits of self and family members
