### Official Bill

#### Bill # 564

I, Lexi Caldwell and I, Alina Golder, Middle School Representatives, propose the following bill:

The Drunk Drivers No More Act. This act is lowering the blood alcohol content (BAC) from 0.08% to 0.03%. The BAC is the amount of alcohol you have in your blood after drinking.

Reasons for the bill:

Every minute one person is involved in an alcohol related accident and is injured.

There are seventeen countries that have zero tolerance for any level of BAC while you are driving. Some of these countries include Fiji, Hungary, Russia, Saudi Arabia, and Brazil.

There was a woman that admitted to being drunk and she couldn't even run in a straight line. Then the cops gave her a breath test and it said she had a level of 0.06% BAC level and she could still legally drive. She knew that she was hammered, but she could still drive legally.

Even at a level of 0.03% BAC, your concentration is impaired and you definitely need to be able to concentrate to drive.

At any level of BAC, a younger person is more likely to be involved in an accident than an older person.

If this bill were broken, the consequence would be:
